Paperwork must be signed and completed to be accepted. Appropriate spelling and grammar will be factored into final score.

Selection will be made without regard to applicant's race, color, ethnicity, religion, gender or physical handicap. Five students are selected from high schools in the nine counties of Maryland's Eastern Shore. Selection is based on the completed application, essay, and video.
